CPSWQ Registrants must understand the minimum requirements for the US EPA National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit program and/or Canada's Department of Fisheries and Oceans Requirements, as related to storm water quality.

Registrants must demonstrate proficiencies in Pollutants in Storm Water Runoff, Watershed Hydrology, Quantifying Pollutants in Storm Water, and BMPs for Urbanizing Areas.

Certification Program

- The Certified Professional in Storm Water Quality program was created over 10 years ago to provide professional credentials to individuals working with storm water issues. Individuals holding the CPSWQ certification have the knowledge and abilities to help projects meet federal, state and local NPDES storm water requirements. CPSWQ certification may be accepted by some local, state and federal governments.

Mission Statement

The public demands evidence of professional competence from persons whose activities affect the physical and economical well being of people throughout the world. Such professionals increasingly must be able to show evidence of their qualifications. CPSWQ, Inc. issues certification to individuals based upon thorough examination and review of such person's educational, scientific and service knowledge, training, experience and activities in both the public and private sector. CPSWQ, Inc. has developed standards and procedures for certifying persons who are qualified to practice in the field of storm water quality and seeks to promote the common business interests of persons who are so certified.

Candidates must submit their application along with a required fee. Following application review and approval, they must complete a written examination to demonstrate their knowledge and skills for effective use of storm water methods on sites.



Candidate Qualifications

Candidates must have at least seven (7) years of directly related experience and possess a high school diploma (or equivalent) along with work references. Individuals having a degree may receive credit for their education.

Additional Provisions

Registrants must subscribe to a Code of Conduct and Ethics, pay an annual renewal fee and provide proof of continuing education credits. Individuals interested in certification should check with the appropriate regulatory authorities to determine acceptance of this certification.

Note that certification is not a substitute for any required professional license.

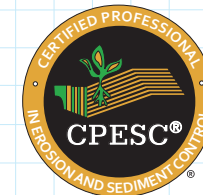
